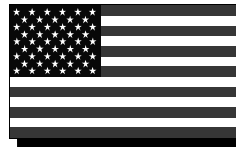

The Game committee will host a youth pheasant hunt for the 2010 -2011 season. Look for applications and information in the next newsletter and on the Club's website.

In addition to PA Game regulations, the following rules apply when hunting on Club grounds:

- ◆ No single projectiles while hunting with firearms on Club grounds, hunting is limited to shotguns and archery equipment.
- ◆ Hunters must wear a fluorescent orange hat for all hunting on Club grounds; this is in addition to any fluorescent orange required by PA game laws.
- ◆ Tree stands may not be left on Club property, and must be carried in and out each day.
- ◆ Hunters using tree stands are required to wear a full body harness while on Club property.

Please hunt safely and respect safety zones while on Club property.



Please dispose of all used fishing line in the trash cans located throughout the property. Improper disposal of fishing line in the water or on land harms fish, birds, wildlife and the Club's equipment. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Orange Hat / Vest Policy

A Florescent orange hat or vest is mandatory on the rifle range and while hunting. Not to supersede Pennsylvania Game Commission laws. Recommended, but not mandatory for all others. All Pennsylvania Game Commission laws apply.

The outdoor season ends on September 29th with a Multi-gun match. We have had a great outdoor season with a few new faces and many from the old group. We will move indoors on November 3rd for the Fall / Winter Bulls-eye league (50 foot , 22 caliber rim-fire). Please wear eye and ear protection while on the ranges (this includes both shooters and spectators). You only get one pair of eyes per life time.



Rifle

The . 22 rim fire, 200 yards will continue to be held every second Tuesday night from 7:00 to 10:00p with October 12th being the last match. The small bore league will begin on November 9th. High- power, National Match will continue every second Sunday though October. There will be an 8:00a sign- in and the shoots will run from 9:00a - 1:00p. Ranges are closed to the members those days and hours.

It's that time of year again where the ranges will get busy prior to hunting season. Please be safe and courteous while at the range. Please remember to wear your EYE and EAR protection while on all ranges (pistol , rifle and trap). This applies to spectators as well. Eye protection must be approved safety glass. Sunglasses that are prescription are allowed. The \$5.00 Kmart specials are not considered safety eye wear. This rule is for your safety and is non- negotiable. Please police your brass and place it into the containers.

The junior/senior basic rifle course will be held in January, February and March 2011. Orange hats/vests are mandatory on the rifle range at all times. The exception is sanctioned Club matches.

All members must be aware of the ranges and impact areas and stay out of them, PERIOD. All members need to be careful were they venture on the property at all times.
