Ten Commandments of Safe Gun Handling

- 1). Always point the muzzle in a safe direction.**
- 2). Treat every firearm as though it were loaded.**
- 3). Unload firearms and open action except when ready to shoot.**
- 4). Keep barrel clear and choose proper ammunition for firearm.**
- 5). Be sure of your target before you pull the trigger.**
- 7). Never climb or jump with a loaded firearm.**
- 8). Never shoot at a flat hard surface or water.**
- 9). Store firearms and ammunition safely.**
- 10). Avoid alcohol and drugs before and during shooting.**
