

## Outdoor Pistol Safety Check

- 1: Guns to be bagged at all times ( ammo / mags separate )
- 2: Only place you may handle the gun:
  - A: on the line ( RO commands )
  - B: gun handling table ( no ammo or mags out )
- 3: No drawing from a holster unless you are checked out.
- 4: Use of mag / speed loaders on the belt are allowed.
- 5: Dropping a mag or speed loader, its dead ( DO NOT PICK IT UP ) auto DQ
- 6: Dropping of a gun. ( DO NOT PICK IT UP ) the RO will handle the gun at that point.  
ONLY THE RO
- 7: 180 Rule. ( example , mussle , 180 , etc )
- 8: AD's , there should be none but.
- 9: Barrels are there for extra ammo / speed loaders
- 10: Paper must have 2 good hits. ( 2 min )
- 11: Steel must be down or hit ( falling / static )
- 12: Commands to start.
  - A ( Shooter you may handle , take a sight picture with an empty gun , Shooter , load and make ready)
  - B ( Shooter you may handle and load / make ready on your own command )  
( shooter , low ready , Safety on , Hammer down ( de cocker ) finger off trigger )  
Shooter Nod when Ready  
Shooter ready  
Stand By  
Timer ( buzz )
- 13: End of stage.
  - Shooter , show clear , ( drop mag , Open slide / hold open to allow RO to review chamber to ensure gun is empty. ) Slide down , Hammer Down. Bag it
  - Only exception ( guns that require a Mag to hammer down. )
  - Revolvers < open cylinder and show empty , Close and bag it.
- 14: no moving backwards with a gun. Period ( Un bagged gun )

### Common issues:

- Finger on the trigger.
- Safety flipped off before the buzzer
- Finger on the trigger during reloads.
- Sweeping hand with hot gun during stages.
- Sweeping feet with hot gun during stages.
- Breaking 180 run when moving with gun from side to side
- Gun in case facing rear ward on the line when case is opened. ( mark case for muzzle )
